## NATIONAL KAPPA KAPPA IOTA, INC. EDUCATIONAL GRANT

National Kappa Kappa lota Educational Grants were established to assist non-member educators in pursuit of professional and personal growth. It is most important that all selections of applicants for a National Kappa Kappa lota Educational Grant be made on the basis of the following qualifications:

## I. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS FOR AN EDUCATIONAL GRANT

- A. The applicant must be a person who is currently, or will be, devoting a major part of his/her time to teaching or allied work.
- B. The applicant must have a worthy reason for wanting a grant for professional enrichment, for a degree, or for advancement/addition to a degree program, or for certification/recertification.
- C. The applicant must take courses, seminars, or conferences with an accredited college or university for college credit.
- D. The applicant must have been active in religious, social, educational or civic organizations.
- E. The applicant may or may not have a special need for financial assistance, but the Kappa Kappa Iota National Scholarship Committee may give special attention to financial need in making a choice between two equally worthy applicants.
- F. National Kappa Kappa Iota Educational Grants will not be awarded to Kappa members or previous recipients.

## II. APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Applications can be obtained from the National Kappa Kappa Iota website (nationalkappakappaiota.org), through Kappa Kappa Iota National Headquarters, 1875 E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Tulsa, OK 74104-4610, or from a State Scholarship Chair.
- B. Applications must be typed, filled in completely, and answered concisely. Additional pages may be added only in the event that space is not sufficient on the form.
- C. Include an estimate of the amount of grant money needed.
- D. All forms must be completed and signed by the applicant.
- E. The applicant must send the completed original grant application form to the National Scholarship Chair. The applicant must also send copies of the application form to each member of the National Scholarship Committee.
- F. Grant applications submitted to the National Scholarship Chair must be postmarked no later than June 1.

## III. RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS

The recipient must submit the following to the National Kappa Kappa Iota, 1875 East 15th St., Tulsa, OK 74104-4610

- A. Receipt of proof of enrollment and verification of payment for course/program is required before grant award is paid.
- B. An official transcript from the university/college attended showing the course work completed, date of attendance, and credit hours earned.
- C. A short, precise report as to courses, seminars, etc. taken.
