Section 1 - Rules for the National Nominating Committee Members

- a. Each chartered state shall send an elected member (or elected alternate for the elected member) to a National Nominating Committee meeting at the National Convention.
- b. Each member shall have attended two out of the last five National Conventions prior to the present one except for states less than five years old.
- c. No state shall send the same member to the committee more than two (2) years in succession.
- d. A quorum of the National Nominating Committee shall consist of those members present.
- e. A state that does not have a qualified elected member or a qualified elected alternate in attendance at the National Nominating Committee meeting shall forfeit its representation on the committee for that year's meeting.
- f. Members are responsible for all expenses incurred to attend the National Nominating Committee meeting.

Section 5 - Courtesy of Committee Members

- a. A candidate for a national office cannot serve on the National Nominating Committee.
- b. The National Parliamentarian cannot serve as a member of the National Nominating Committee.
- c. All persons attending the National Nominating Committee meeting shall keep in strict confidence all discussion within the committee.

*Any member who does not have the form sent in by May 1 must be certified prior to the meeting.
