First, plan to complete the 2025 National Convention Registration form and mail it to Barbara Garrison by May 1, 2025. Next, reserve your room at the Read House Chattanooga, the official convention hotel. It's fun to share a room so be sure to check with your local and state Kappas to find a roommate. You can also go on the National Kappa Facebook page to reach out to others if you need help finding a roommate.

To decide what to register for, review the conference schedule on page 8 for an overview of the events of the convention. Note that everything happens at the hotel and there are "add-on" excursions off site that you can attend if you want. The fees for all events are listed on the registration form. There are many Kappas who don't do tours and choose to stay at the hotel and socialize during these times. You can customize your time as you wish. Everyone is very friendly so you will be welcome at all events with open arms!

As a first timer you might not know some things that happen during convention. We have raffles, opportunities to support local philanthropic projects, and time to socialize. When you're packing, consider bringing a child's book and a teddy bear to donate and some cash to purchase Kappa items and special project tickets.

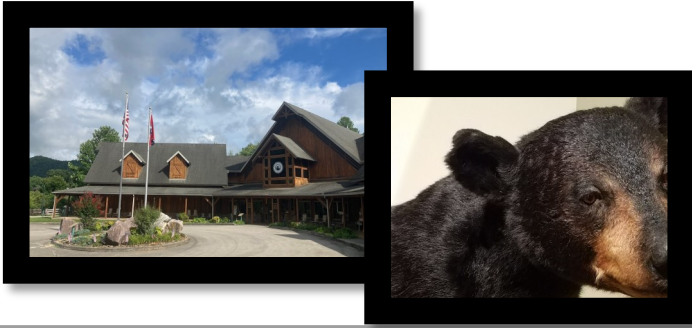

Southern Belle Dinner Cruise Tuesday, June 24, 2025, 5:30- 7:30 pm

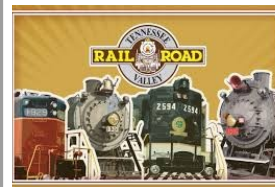

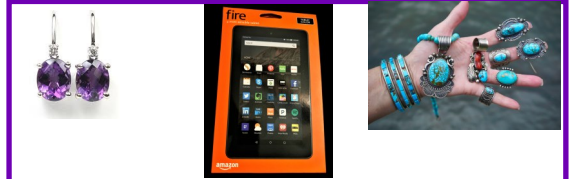
